MINI Convertible The 2025 MINI Cooper Convertible is a fun-focused, open-top car that combines playful design with spirited driving dynamics.

Design & Personality

- Retains the iconic MINI charm with a cleaner, more modern exterior and a customizable soft-top (including a Union Jack pattern option) 312.
- The interior features a 9.5-inch circular OLED touchscreen, minimalist controls, and playful mood lighting. Unique to the convertible is the "Always Open Timer", which tracks roof-down driving time for bragging rights 3412.
